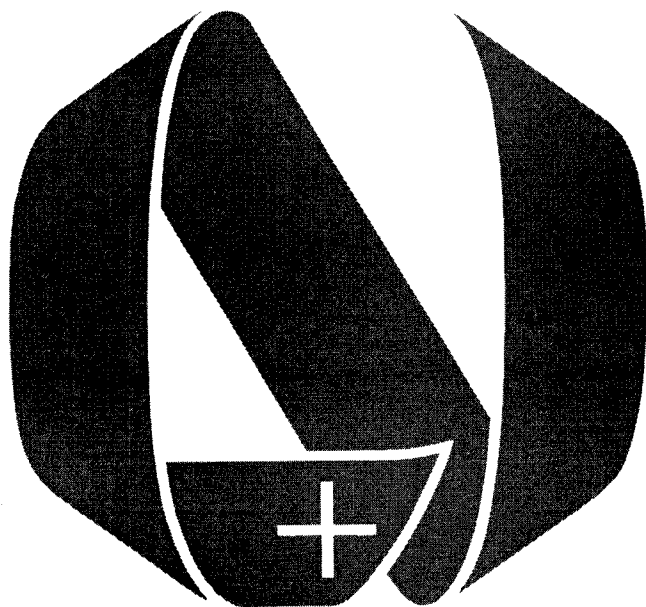

The Commencement Speaker

Andrew Hsiao, theologian, educator, editor, and currently president of Lutheran Theological Seminary in Hong Kong, is the speaker for the 124th Commencement of Luther Northwestern Theological Seminary.

Now on sabbatical, he is spending this year at Luther Northwestern as a research scholar while he works on a book, *Historical Development in Chinese Theological Education*.

Hsiao has had a distinguished career of leadership in the Lutheran Church in Hong Kong. He was a lecturer at the Lutheran Theological Seminary from 1958 to 1965 before being named professor of religious education in 1970. He became president the next year.

He was editor/editor-in-chief of the Taosheng Publishing House in Hong Kong in 1952-54 and 1958-65.

Other church leadership positions have included chair of the Hong Kong Christian Council (1974-76); chair, Association for Theological Education in South East Asia (1977-81); vice president, Lutheran World Federation (1977-84); trustee, United Board for Christian Higher Education in Asia (1980-86); and chair of the Hong Kong Theological Education Association (1991 to the present).

Among his writings are "Good Tidings Sunday School Material," which he designed, wrote and edited as the first entirely indigenous Sunday School curriculum material in the Chinese church. He is also the author of *Introduction to Christian Religious Education*, a textbook written in 1986 for Chinese speaking seminaries.

Hsiao earned the bachelor of theology degree from Lutheran Theological Seminary in Hong Kong in 1952. He also holds a bachelor of arts degree from Augsburg College, Minneapolis (1956) the master of religious education degree from New York Theological Seminary (1958), and the Ph.D. degree from New York University (1970).

He was ordained in the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Hong Kong in 1971.

Hsiao has been honored by Augsburg College with the Distinguished Alumni Citation (1970) and the Distinguished Service Citation (1980). He also received the Distinguished Service Award from Pacific Lutheran University in Tacoma, Wash., (1982) and the Christopher Tang Christian Literature Award (1987).

While he plans to retire in January, 1994, Hsiao says that in retirement he will "concentrate on writing while continuing teaching and preaching."

The Christus Lux Mundi Award is being presented to Andrew Hsiao — pastor, educator, theologian, author, church leader — by Luther Northwestern today as part of the seminary's 124th Commencement ceremonies.

The Christus Lux Mundi Award

The second Christus Lux Mundi Award is being presented to Andrew Hsiao, Commencement speaker, as part of Luther Northwestern's 124th Commencement service today. The name of the award originates from the Latin inscription carved in the stone above the main entrance to Gullixson Hall, the home of the Luther Northwestern library.

That inscription (translated "Christ the Light of the World") articulates the central purpose of the seminary and identifies the kind of ministry and service to which the seminary is committed.

The Christus Lux Mundi Award is the most distinguished award presented by Luther Northwestern. It honors the witness and service of persons who have manifested the light of Christ during a long and distinguished career either in the pastoral office or as a lay person. No more than one of the awards is presented a year.

The award is an upright jade crystal block etched with the name of the recipient and an artist's sketch of the entrance to Gullixson Hall which includes the words, Christus Lux Mundi.

The first Christus Lux Mundi Award was presented during Commencement last year to President Emeritus Alvin N. Rogness, president and professor of pastoral theology and ministry from 1955 until he retired in 1974. Rogness died last summer on July 12 at the age of 86
