THE POSTLUDE

The Commencement Speaker

Paul J. Dovre, a widely recognized and respected leader in higher education, has been president of Concordia College in Moorhead, Minn., since 1975.

He joined Concordia's faculty in 1963 as an assistant professor of speech and served as an associate dean of the college and academic dean and vice president before being named to the presidency.

The Council for the Advancement and Support of Education (CASE) lists him as one of the 100 most effective chief executives in higher education.

He was elected in January to the board of the Council of Independent Colleges, a national association of independent colleges and universities.

He was a member of the commission that designed the merger which formed the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA). He has been president of the Lutheran Educational Conference of North America, and was a delegate to the Lutheran World Assembly in Curitiba, Brazil, in January, 1990.

He graduated from Concordia in 1958, and studied at Luther Seminary for one year. He holds both the masters and doctoral degrees in speech communication from Northwestern University.

The Endowed Chairs

Two endowed faculty chairs are being announced during Commencement services today. They are the Elva B. Lovell Endowed Chair of Old Testament and the Pastor George C. Weinman Endowed Chair of Pastoral Theology and Ministry.

The first member of the faculty to occupy the Lovell Chair is Terence E. Fretheim, professor of Old Testament. Robert H. Albers, professor of pastoral care, is the first to occupy the Weinman Chair.

Both chairs are funded by Elva Lovell, who died in 1991, with assets from a trust agreement made with Luther Northwestern Theological Seminary (an antecedent of Luther Seminary) in 1987.

The lives of Mrs. Lovell and Pastor Weinman came together when she became a member of Central Lutheran Church in Minneapolis, where he was a member of the pastoral staff. She was active in a women's guild, a Bethel class, and the Central Lutheran Church Women as well as Bible studies. She met Pastor Weinman when he was teaching one of the Bible classes. When her husband died, Mrs. Lovell asked Pastor Weinman to officiate at his funeral.

Elva Lovell grew up in a modest home in Michigan. After high school, where she was motivated to "set her sights high," her interest in medical laboratory work led her to the Mayo Clinic where she met her husband Walter.

Later in life she was afflicted with multiple sclerosis and hired seminary students to help take care of her. When such care was no longer adequate, she moved to the Lake Ridge Care Center. While there, she began to work out arrangements for her estate that would help her realize her dream of providing financial assistance for students and undergirding the mission of the seminary.

Her earliest gifts to the seminary established a student scholarship program. Her substantial bequest has made it possible for Luther Seminary to announce its first two fully-funded endowed faculty chairs today.

Terence Fretheim was first connected with the Luther Seminary faculty as a teaching fellow in Greek in 1958-60 while still a student. He returned as an assistant professor in 1968 and became a professor of Old Testament in 1978. He was dean of academic affairs for ten years, beginning in 1978.

Robert Albers became a member of the Luther Seminary faculty as an assistant professor in 1981 and was promoted to professor ten years later. He directed the Ministry in Pastoral Care and Social Change program in 1985 and was the acting dean of students in 1982-83.
